Thursday Night - An 8 week discipleship course facilitated by Pastor Gary starting October 6th at North Grenville Community Church, at 7 PM

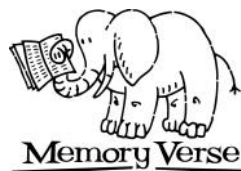
