<sup>15</sup> My frame was not hidden from you when I was made in the secret place, when I was woven together in the depths of the earth. <sup>16</sup> Your eyes saw my unformed body; all the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be.

<sup>17</sup> How precious to me are your thoughts, <sup>(a)</sup> God! How vast is the sum of them!

<sup>18</sup> Were I to count them, they would outnumber the grains of sand—when I awake, I am still with you. <sup>19</sup> If only you, God, would slay the wicked! Away from me, you who are bloodthirsty

<sup>20</sup> They speak of you with evil intent; your adversaries misuse your name.

<sup>21</sup> Do I not hate those who hate you, LORD, and abhor those who are in rebellion against you? <sup>22</sup> I have nothing but hatred for them; I count them my enemies.

<sup>23</sup> Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts.

<sup>24</sup> See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.
