Luke 19:28-31 Celebrations can require planning.

Luke 19:32-36 If a colt and coats and palm branches are in your celebration plans it's a humble plan. (No marching band)

Luke 19:37-38 When we recognize who Jesus is we can't help but celebrate in praise.



Luke 19:39 - There will always be naysayers

Luke 19:40 - It's creation job to praise God.

Isaiah 55:12 - You will go out in joy and be led forth in peace; the mountains and hills will burst into song before you, and all the trees of the field will clap their hands.



Romans 1:20 - For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities--his eternal power and divine nature--have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse.

Luke 19:41-44 Failure to recognize God's coming can result in destruction
